PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Iowa has a very rich history of successfully identifying and achieving significant opportunities.

dating from the State's becoming a part of the United States in 1803, with the Louisiana Purchase; American settlements starting in the early 1830's, with Dubuque as Iowa's oldest city, in 1933; and Iowa receiving Statehood in 1846. Such landmark activities continue to this day; and

WHEREAS, Iowa's history of individual and organizational achievement has become a part of our daily

vocabulary and its success has fueled the economies of our Iowa cities, towns, and rural areas; and

WHEREAS, the State of Iowa has enjoyed times of plenty and addressed challenging time through hard work

and determination, creating an internationally recognized "Iowa Work Ethic"; and

WHEREAS, our State's motto "Our Liberties We Prize and Our Rights We Will Maintain" speaks to our

enduring faith and right to be Iowans and our focus on the opportunities that present themselves

and move us forward; and

WHEREAS, Opportunity Nation, a national bipartisan initiative, is working to build a national dialogue on

opportunity as a core American value, that desperately needs to be injected into the public conversation; and that through commitment, intelligence, and partnership, Opportunity Nation believes we can reenergize this public value in American discourse as a vital national goal; and

WHEREAS, as Governor of the great State of Iowa, I recognize that the pursuit of "opportunity" is a core Iowa

value, whether it be for an individual, family, agency, company or governmental agency:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Terry E. Branstad, Governor of the State of Iowa, do hereby proclaim February, 2012 as

OPPORTUNITY IN IOWA MONTH

AND ENCOURAGE IOWANS, AND ALL PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ORGANIZATIONS, TO CONDUCT ONE OR MORE EVENTS OR ACTIVITIES WITH THE THEME OF "OPPORTUNITY IN IOWA".
